- Adopting policies that give the district direction to set priorities and achieve its goals.
- Hiring and evaluating the superintendent.
- Adopting and overseeing the annual budget.
- Setting Strategic Plan for school
- Reporting to the Idaho Public Charter School Commission
- Is accountable to taxpayers of Idaho and Stakeholders of TVCS

Time Commitment 5-10 hours per month:

- Attending Monthly Board Meetings, 3rd Thursday of Every Month from 6:00 until 8:30/9 pm.
- Attending Board Retreat, we typically hold 1-2 half-day long retreats each school year for planning and training
- Responding to Emails in a timely manner
